

WBIDC participated in IITF 2011



The 31st edition of the popular annual mega trade fair, the India International Trade Fair (IITF) was organized at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi from November 14 to 27, 2011. Like every year this year also IITF presented an impressive range of products from artisans to MNCs covering diverse sectors. The fair received participation from almost all states and Union Territories of India along with several domestic and foreign companies.
