Subject: Prebid meeting held on Survey of Industrial Parks, dated 5th January 2011
(Wednesday)

Minutes

The meeting commenced as per schedule on 05.01.11 (Wednesday) at 15.00 hours in the Board Room of WBIDC office in presence of :

Four interested companies attended the meeting were represented by :

2. Shri Avijit Banerjee, Softa Computer
3. Shri Rathin Chatterjee, Global Surveyors
4. Shri Subroto Porey, G.D. Surveyors

It was mainly an interactive session where clarifications were duly given on a few queries made by the representatives of the attending companies.

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Following clarifications had been made :

1. Number of mouza maps would have to be procured by the selected company.
2. Outer periphery of the parks would not be physically shown by WBIDC Ltd. Boundary on the map shown would have to be considered.
3. Specification of instruments (*e.g. TSM*) in the tender document to be adhered to by way of acknowledgment through capacity certificate.
4. Composite quotation on acreage basis for all industrial parks should be given and that must include all taxes.
5. Regarding dimension of reference pillar, designs to be supplied by WBIDC Ltd., along with specification.
6. Financial bid and technical bid are to be put in two different sealed envelopes and together those two would be placed in a third envelop which has to be submitted.
7. Since georeference of map is made desirable in the tender document, values of pillar ought to be global.
8. Details of land schedule including plot nos. would have to be covered by survey.
9. Land use, as per field to be detailed in three layers - primary, secondary and tertiary.
10. Survey works, as specified in point No.2 1) a) would circumscribe point No.2 (ii) a to f in its entirety
11. Position of reference pillar is to be fixed and supplied by agency.
12. In reference to point No.2 (ii) & at least five points in coordinators should be taken in every 100 acres of polygon. However, for quantum of land less than that, coordinates may be proportionate.
